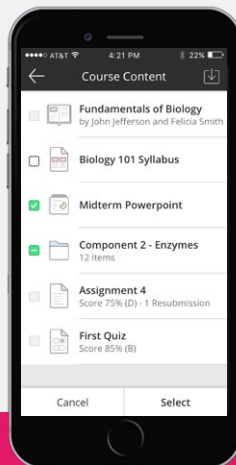
A better learning experience

- **Reduced data usage:** Download content in advance to avoid using limited data



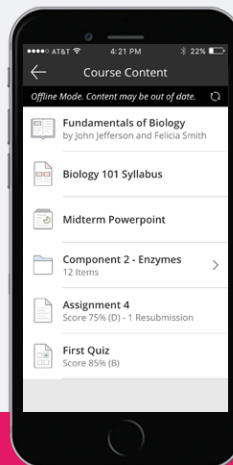
Step 1
