Release highlights

- All activity can be queried and viewed, including instructor activity when instructors initiated a student preview session.
- When an extract's execution overlaps with the background process they no longer execute concurrently. The background process waits for the extract request to finish executing.
- When the execution of an extract request is aborted because of an application server crash, the status of the request is updated to reflect the failure when the application server starts up again.
- The number of modified courses processed by the view materialization process is now logged for each materialized view in the extract log. This allows us to correlate the materialization time with the number of modified courses.
- An unnecessary transaction wrapping the entire extraction process was removed. This should result in a small improvement in the performance of the extract operation.
- Extract requests can now utilize multiple threads for view materialization and disk output. The number of threads can be configured on the Building Block **Settings** page. This value defaults to one;

it can be increased to allow extract requests to complete faster. Generally, two to five threads should be sufficient for most installations.

 *The greater number of threads, the larger the impact on database server performance and general application responsiveness.*
