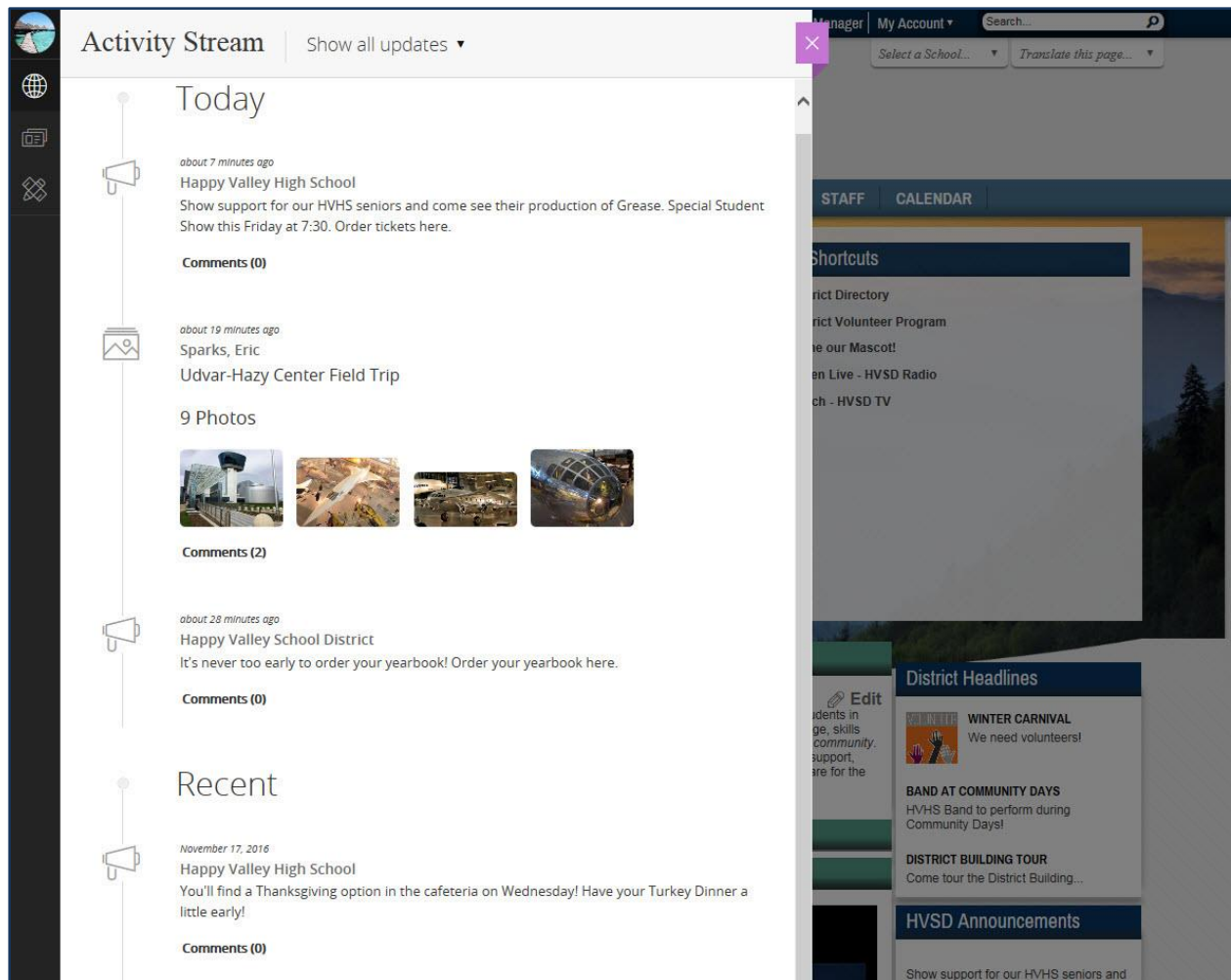

Basic Dashboard

You now have the ability to activate the [Basic Dashboard](#). It will provide a new experience for users who are signed in to the website. They'll see updates from sites as well as other areas to which they have subscribed without navigating to the site.

If you are a registered user and sign in to your website, you see an *Activity Stream*. The Activity Stream displays feeds from the Web Community Manager feed apps, namely the Announcements, Blog, Calendar, Headlines & Features and Photo Gallery. You can also access *PassKeys*, *Sidebar Help* and *Sign Out* of the website from the Dashboard. If you have editing privileges, you can access *Site Manager* as well.

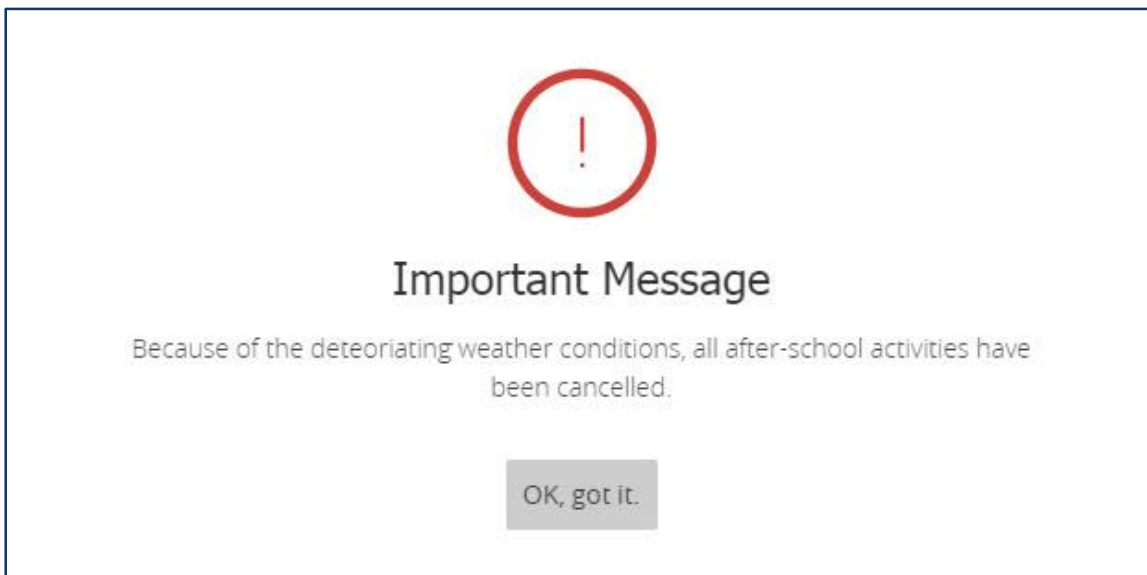


Note that if you previously had MyView activated, you'll need to contact us to activate the Basic Dashboard.

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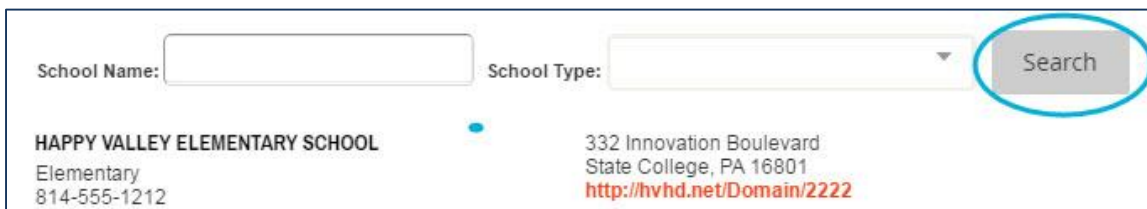
On-Screen Alerts





When you display a map in the Maps & Directions App, you'll see that Google Maps is updated. You can zoom to see more detail, view a larger map or sign in and save the map. You'll also see that the end user display has changed.

Driving Directions

From Washington, DC, and points south: Take I-66 West to Route 28 North (Exit 53B): Travel on Route 28 North for 5.3 miles. Exit at Air and Space Museum Parkway and follow the signs to the Udvar-Hazy Center.

From Washington, DC, and points north: Take I-495 West (Capital Beltway) to the Dulles Toll Road West (Route 267). Exit the toll road at Route 28 South (Exit 9A) and travel south 3.5 miles. Exit at Air and Space Museum Parkway and follow the signs to the Udvar-Hazy Center.

From points west: Take I-66, Route 29, or Route 50 East to Route 28 North.

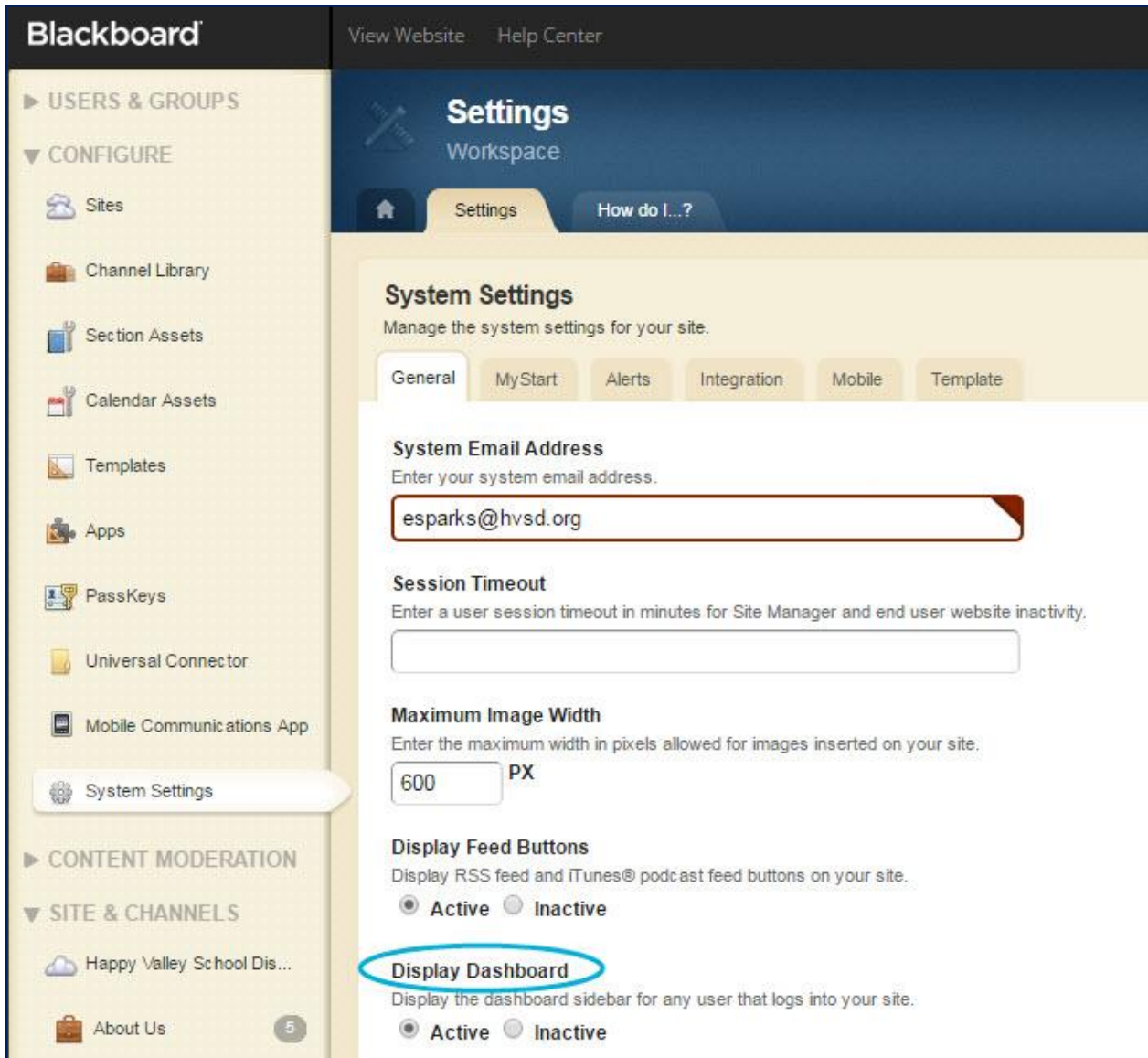
Please note, online mapping services may direct you to enter the Udvar-Hazy Center from Route 50. This is not a public entrance. You must enter from Route 28.

System Settings—Activate the Basic Dashboard

With this release you have access to the Basic Dashboard. By default, the Dashboard will be set to Inactive. To activate the Basic Dashboard, open System Settings in Site Manager and click the activate radio button under Display Dashboard on the General tab.

We have resolved the following issues in this release. We've listed the issues as they were originally entered.

| Accessibility | Incorrect aria attribute assignment for the channel section menu |
| Accessibility | Rating control is not optimized for screen reader |
| Accessibility | Global search input needs descriptive title for form fields. |
| Accessibility | New registration age screen needs descriptive titles for form fields |
| Accessibility | My Account Information needs valid labels for form fields (city, zip, state, street2) |
| Accessibility | Channel directory filter accessibility changes |
| Accessibility | Add proper heading hierarchy to section directory |
| Accessibility | Move today button after the day/week/month/list segment control |
| Accessibility | Change App Sidebar headings to H1 instead H2 |
| Active Blocks | [\$\$SITENAME\$] is pulling menu name instead of site name |
| App Builder | Special characters not being escaped/encoded - creating issues for some of Creative team's custom apps |
| Calendar App | When a client edits a recurring event with Google Sync turned on it will create a duplicate event |
| Calendar App | Unable to delete duplicate events on Web Community Manager after the event has been created and modified in Google |

| Calendar App | Unable to sync with a Google calendar if there is an apostrophe in the name. |
| Document Viewer App | Remove the background: none; on div.ui-widget.app.detail .ui-widget-header |
| File Links | When we try to insert a file link it doesn't show any existing files |
| Friendly Web Address | Friendly URL Character Limit is too small increase to 500 characters |
| Photo Gallery App | Unable to upload images using the Select File option on Firefox 50 (latest version) |
| Section Workspace | Section Workspace - Chrome FF and IE - Site Manager scrolls to top of workspace when selecting Set Viewers |
| Smart Device | iPad cannot access a channel that has no section but does have a homepage |
| Table App | Table with several images or large amounts of content can cause the table to only partially loads and no scrollbar is present to navigate the rest of content. IE, Chrome and Safari browsers |
| Table App | When images selected from Existing/Shared images > subfolder are not adding to table |
| TinyMCE Apps | No context menu after insert image |
