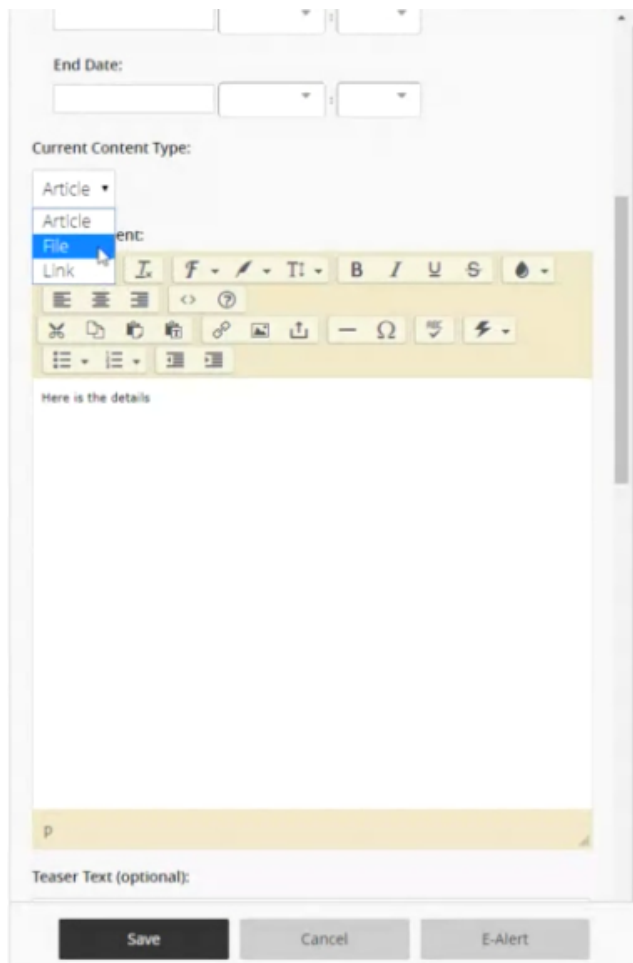

Resolved Issues

We have resolved the following issues in this release. We've listed the issues as they were originally entered and in the order that they were reported.

<i>Functional Area</i>	<i>Subject</i>
Google Sync	The user will not be able to sync their Google calendar if Google has not provided valid tokens
LDAP	Unable to login to sites with LDAP
Content Moderation	Clicking on Approval Queue in Site Manager causes occasional error message
Wiki app	Upload from Cloud storage is available for the end user
Site Manager	Section editors aren't able to access Site Manager if one of their sections has been deleted.
Assignments app	Users are unable to edit older assignments
Site name	Apostrophes in the site name field cause rendering problems with templates
User accounts	Editing permissions tab is sometimes blank for users even though they have valid editing permissions
Calendar	Registered event emails were not being sent
Calendar	Removed the period after May
Calendar	Moved the colon closer to the event title
Calendar	Last day to register cannot be the current date
Twitter	Twitter wasn't working due to a change in Twitter's API
Content Moderation	"Send for Approval" button was appearing in 2 situations where it should not be appearing.
