Release Highlights

xpLor is a cloud-based learning object repository that is designed to work with multiple Learning Management Systems (LMS). It is built on open standards and allows for the creation, discovery, and sharing of rich learning objects. You can share learning objects beyond the confines of a single LMS. Shared objects work in any supported system without alteration. You can move existing content from the LMS platform to xpLor, making it accessible in multiple courses on multiple platforms.

The xpLor Dashboard summarizes a user's activity and gives direct links to available actions within the system: Authoring, Sharing, Copyright, Discovery, and Delivery. To learn more, see [About xpLor](#).

Basic and Premium xpLor


xpLor provides two models: basic and premium.

The **basic** model requires acceptance of the xpLor license, but it does not require any additional charges. Users have access to a restricted subset of xpLor functions and are limited to Open Educational Resources (OER) sharing and discovery.

The **premium** model allows full access to all xpLor functions.

The following table illustrates the difference between the basic and premium models.

 To visually determine which license xpLor is operating under, look at the application itself. For example, on the **Create** page, basic users have certain sections disabled. A rollover pop-up will alert you that the feature is not available in the basic version.

Important Notes

- xpLor is much more than a content repository. It has tools similar to those in the LMS that offer options to content creators and consumers that were not available before. While xpLor is tightly integrated with the LMS, choosing to use a tool in xpLor could mean less integration with other features in the host environment (LMS). On the other hand, xpLor content is shareable and reusable across courses, the institution, or the world in ways that native LMS content is not. The best option will depend on both individual and institutional goals. Therefore, **we encourage clients to pilot xpLor thoughtfully and to engage with Blackboard to learn how to best leverage this transformational technology. We advise clients to have a communication plan in place before**

enabling the integration. Blackboard has comprehensive consulting and training services to help clients, as well as many online resources clients can access as they explore the possibilities.

- xpLor communicates synchronously with the LMS using an open standard called Learning Tools Interoperability (LTI). xpLor is currently operating on LTI v1.1 framework, but is also accessible using LTI 1.0 without grade pass back. - xpLor resources are loaded within an iframe in the LMS.
- xpLor can pass back grade information to the LMS for interactive resources, eliminating the need for duplication or transfer of grades between systems.
- In addition to the information passed using LTI, xpLor has developed deeper integrations with the various LMS systems to make the interaction between systems more robust. These integrations include passing information about:
 - The structure of courses.
 - Resource titles.
 - Resources present within a course.
- xpLor only supports the import of resource and questions types that are outlined in the Common Cartridge specification. To learn more, see [Common Cartridge](#).
- It is important to note that Common Cartridge is not a perfect standard. Different systems export into Common Cartridge format in different manifestations.
- You can export content from xpLor in "light" Common Cartridge format. This means that users can export LTI (or External Tool) links to content stored within xpLor. Users cannot directly export the content out of the system.
- There are two main types of Digital Rights Management (DRM) within xpLor: Creative Commons licenses and custom institutional or organizational licenses. To learn more, see [About xpLor](#) and [Copyright](#).
