## Facebook Like App User Guide

With the Facebook Like app, you can allow a visitor to like something on your page in a similar way as they like a Facebook post. It's published on the visitor's Facebook feed, increasing visibility and offering a secondary platform for public views. Think of this as a way to share information with parents and the community without having to be directly connected to them on social media.
