

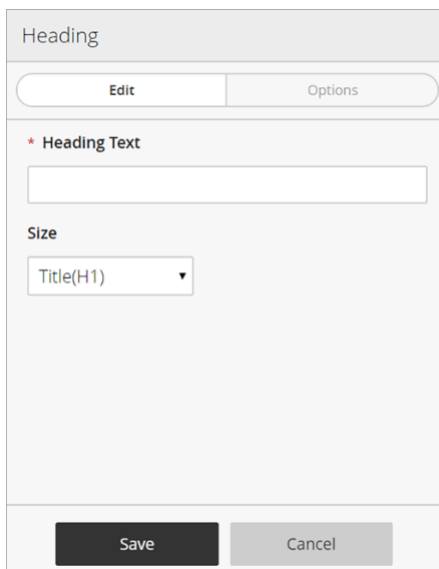
Heading App User Guide

Your device recognizes it as a heading and displays it appropriately.



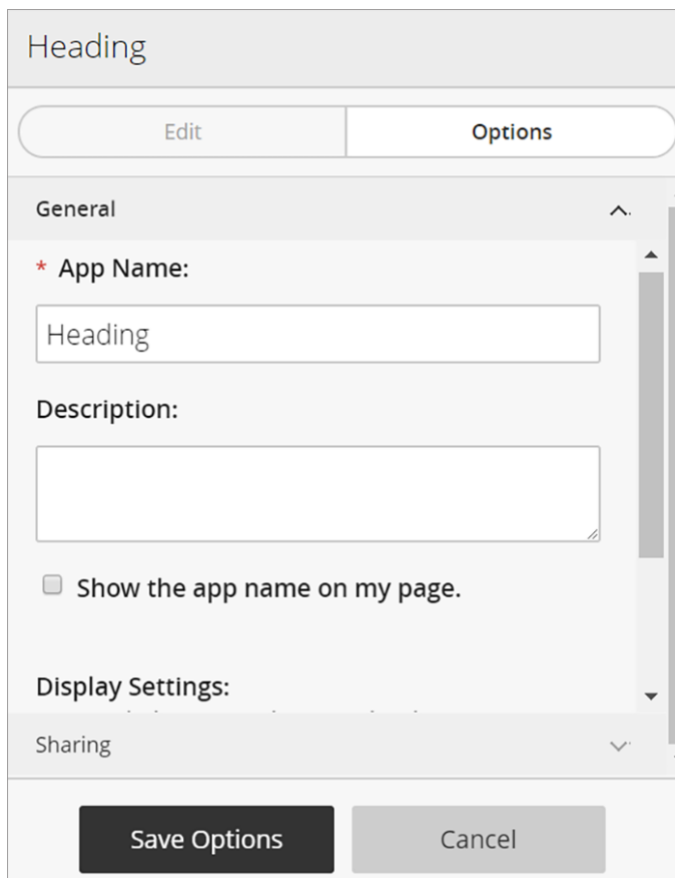
Add the Heading app

Drag the Heading app onto your page.



1. Enter your *Heading Text*.
2. Select your *Heading Size*.
3. Select *Save* when finished.

Set additional options
