## Wiki App User Guide

Use the Wiki app to create collaborative content for your website. Create a wiki at the start of a topic or lesson, for example, and have students add information to it as they learn it. You could use the wiki as a collaborative learning tool where students could create learning wikis and teach each other about a topic.

This wiki is meant to be a collaboration throughout the Paris Unit. As we learn things about Paris, its monuments and its history, fill out the wiki with new facts. Remember you are to post at least 5 new facts before the unit is over in order to receive credit for this wiki.



Drag the Wiki app onto your page.




- 1. Select New Posting.
- 2. Enter the *Posting Title* and the *Body*. You can include links and images and style the text as needed.
- 3. Select Save.



When you've created a wiki, you can lock it, edit it to add additional entries, or delete the wiki.

- 1. Select Options.
- 2. Enter the *App Name* to use as the title.
- 3. Enter the *Description*.
- 4. Select *Show the app name on my page* to display the updated app name.
- 5. Choose the *Display Settings* for the number of posts to list.
